

Mount Kilimanjaro - Tanzania



Mount Kilimanjaro or just Kilimanjaro is a dormant stratovolcano in Tanzania. It is the highest mountain in Africa and the highest single free-standing mountain in the world, with its summit of 19,341 ft above sea level and at about 16,100 ft high from its plateau base.



Kilimanjaro's three volcanic cones, Kibo, Mawenzi, and Shira
Eruptive activity at the Shira centre commenced about 2.5 million years ago.
Both Mawenzi and Kibo began erupting about 1 million years ago.



Kibo is the highest of the volcanic cones. It is dormant and can erupt again.



Located in Tanzania, north next to Kenya, it is on the east side of the Eastern Great Rift Valley
